2022 Annual Virginia Green Travel Star Awards Green Attraction of the Year: Green Leaf and Pebble Tea Spa & Café

Virginia Beach, Virginia



- ➤ During the pandemic, all bulbs were switched to LEDs and low energy equipment and low-flow efficiency toilets and sinks were installed in the kitchen and spa, saving 88% of normal water usage
- ➤ Enrolled in the Dominion Energy Green Power Program so 30% of their power is from renewable sources
- Food waste is now being composted on site



2022 Annual Virginia Green Travel Star Awards Green Brewery of the Year: Stable Craft Brewing

Waynesboro, Virginia



5.8 tons of food waste was composted in2021 and used as fertilizer on the property

The brewery grows its own hops, herbs and peaches and has chickens for eggs

Paralysis furnace creates Bio Char used to amend soil in hop yards and greenhouse

1,100 trees have been planted on the property to help with erosion and air quality

Richmond, Virginia



GREATER RICHMOND CONVENTION CENTER

- Recycling containers located in all administrative offices, meeting rooms and concourses
- Eliminated the use of styrofoam and have decreased use of disposable products
- Restrooms retrofitted with low-flow toilets and low flow aerators installed on sinks
- Conserve energy with fluorescent lighting, converting to LED bulbs when possible and state-of-the-art HVAC and lighting energy management systems

2022 Annual Virginia Green Travel Star Awards Green Event of the Year: Yuengling Shamrock Marathon

Virginia Beach, Virginia

- ➤ Eliminated paper registrations for the marathon and decreased number of savethe-dates that were sent to the 25,000 participants from 6 to only 1
- ➤ All back packs, t-shirts and swag given out at race are reusable
- No single-use items were offered at water stops – instead they had refill zones
- All cardboard and single-use plastic bottles generated by the event were recycled

2022 Annual Virginia Green Travel Star Awards Green Hotel of the Year: Fairfield Kingsgate Property Owners Association, Inc.

Williamsburg, Virginia



- Resort's Green Team meets quarterly to discuss implementation of sustainability goals
- ➤ All property exterior and guest room interior lighting and common area lighting was upgraded to LEDs from 2020-2021
- ➤ Filtered water bottle/cup filling stations installed in public common areas
- The resort saved over \$100,000 in 2021 costs due to their new sustainable practices in electric, water and natural gas use

Richmond, Virginia



James River

Transportation

- ➤ James River Transportation removes 3 million individual car miles from roadways each year with its passenger transportation
- Offices are heated and cooled using geothermal energy
- ➤ They recycle oil, coolant, transmission fluid, filters, cleaning rags, batteries, and electronics
- ➤ James River Transportation saves more energy than it uses which results in 10,000 carbon credits in energy savings

Harrisonburg, Virginia



- ➤ The Mid-Atlantic Electrification
 Partnership is funded by the US DOE
 and is creating a regional electric
 vehicle ecosystem in Maryland, Virginia,
 Washington DC, and West Virginia
- Through various partnerships, VCC is installing EV charging stations at hotels and tourism and city centers throughout the region





➤ The project kicked off in December of 2020, and 5 EV charging stations were installed in 2021 – 200 stations are planned for the coming years

Richmond, Virginia

- Richmond Region Tourism is now offering a Zero Emissions Certificate for conferences held in the Richmond Region
- They are working with the VGTA to purchase carbon credits from renewable energy company Terrapass to offset the carbon impacts associated with business travel
- ➤ Since beginning in 2021, Richmond Region
 Tourism has held 4 zero emission conferences
- Incentivizes business to come to Richmond which helps support its local economy

On behalf of the Virginia Library Association, the Virginia Green Travel Alliance has purchased Carbon Offsets from the company Terrapass. Terrapass is a company that directly supports the development of renewable energy projects such as Wind, Solar & Biomass capture. The projects supported by Terrapass produce zero emissions energy that replaces energy produced by traditional sources that generate greenhouse gases.



Using a carbon calculator, the Virginia Green Travel Alliance assessed the greenhouse gas emissions produced by travel, commuting, energy and water use by the venue and food & beverage.

43 Metric Tons of Carbon Offsets
were purchased to negate the estimated greenhouse gases produced by holding this conference

Newport News, Virginia



- ➤ Education staff worked with local high school volunteers to construct a 30ft long floating wetland with 12 native species in April 2021
- The floating wetland is located in Deer Park
 Lake by a major intersection and removes
 pollutants from the water column, provides
 wildlife habitat and catches litter flowing out
 of the lake
